Over 80% of our clients live on less than \$1USA dollar a day.

Financials:

Since its establishment, we have received supports worth over USA \$200,000 in forms of monitory and material support from individuals donors and organizations in support of our programs.

❑ Solutions we offer:

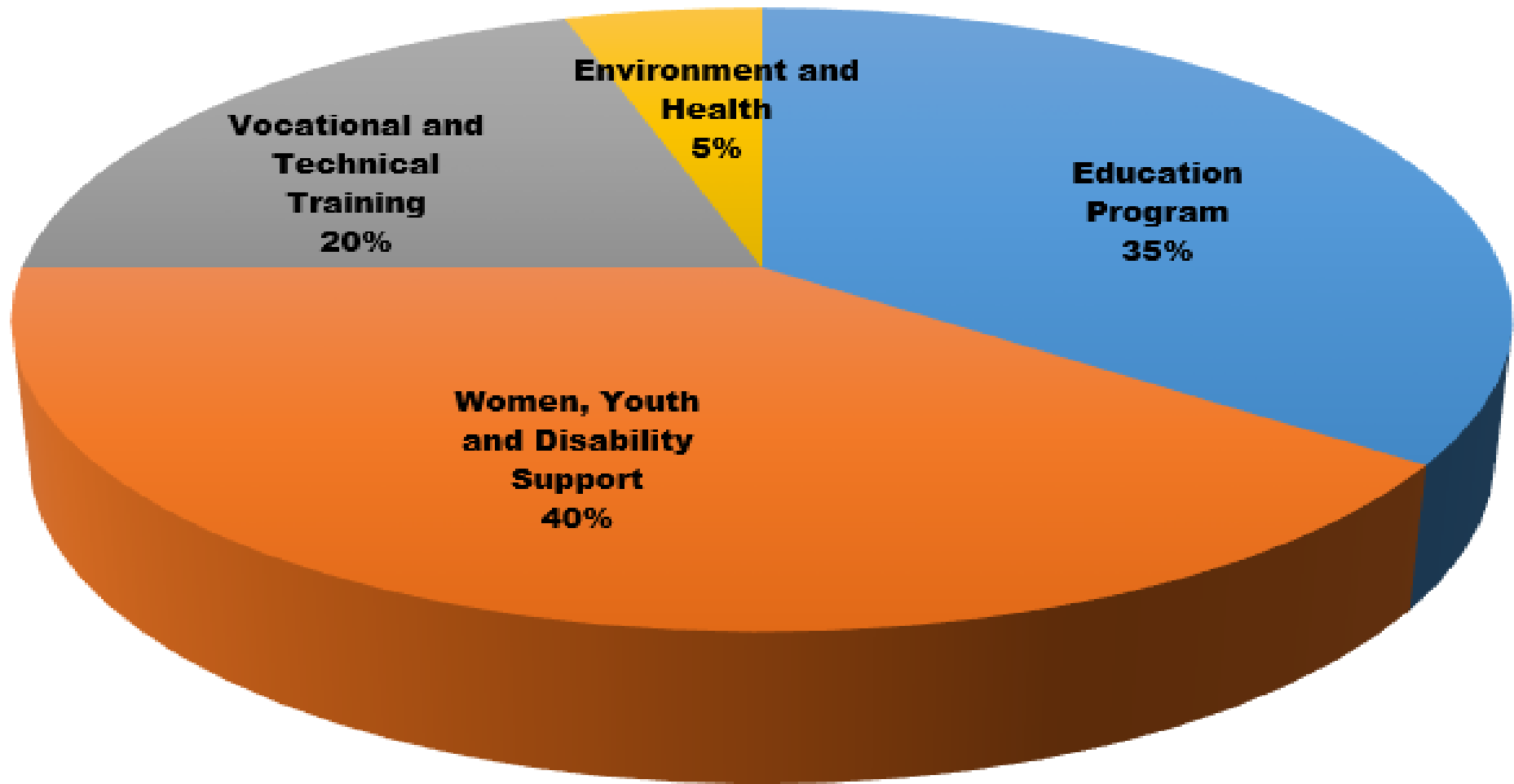
1. Disable and poor youth support through:

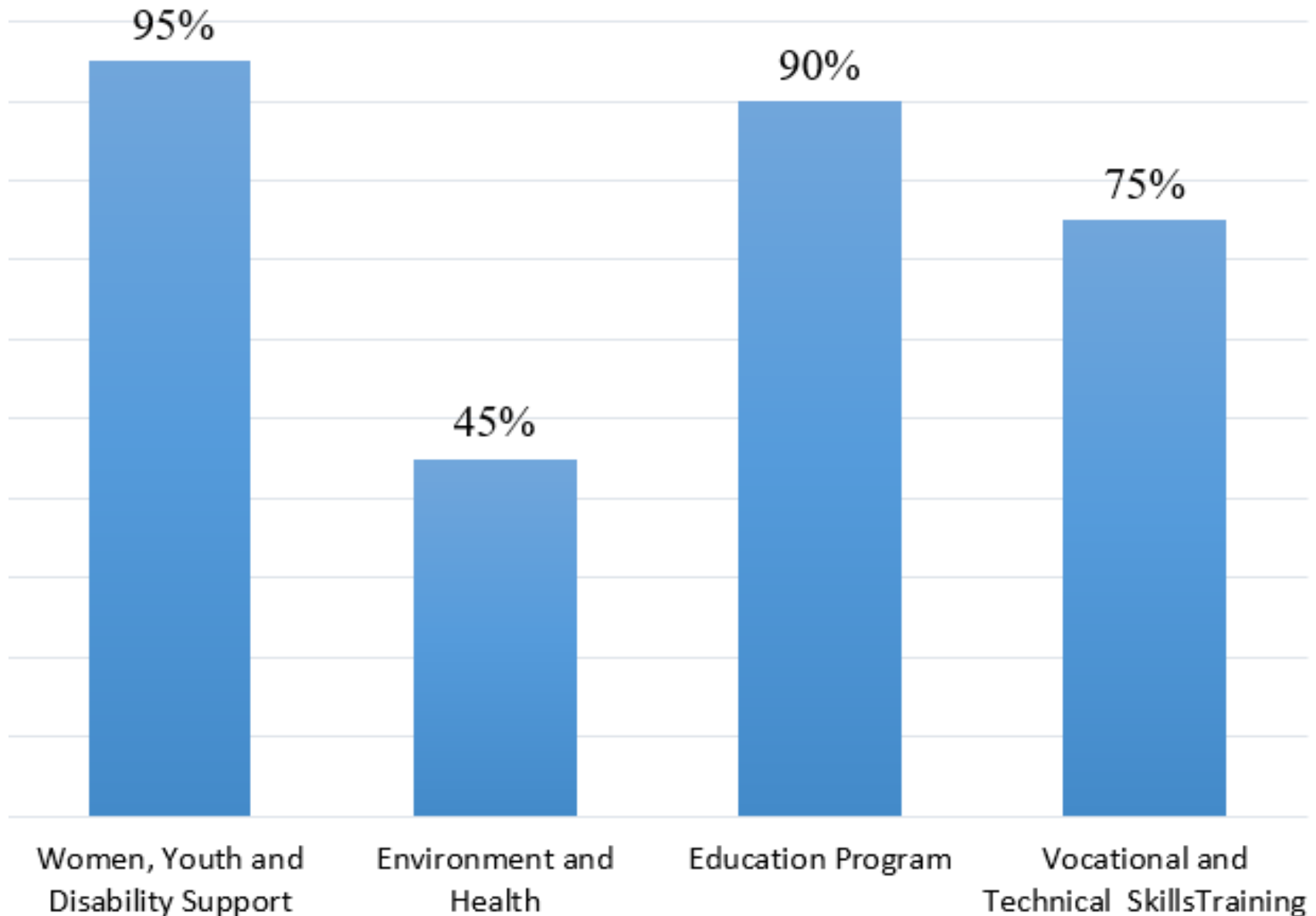

Our Innovative Project for 2021

❑ **Project Title:** Asaasiam Palm Oil and Palm Kernel Oil Production

❑ **Project Goal:**

- To alleviate extreme poverty among over 200 vulnerable women through the production and sale of palm oil and palm kernel oil production.

❑ **Financials:**

An estimated \$65,000 would be needed to construct a commercial scale palm oil production factory

Revenue projections is over \$100000 per annum.

Our Team
