Data of all the 200 vulnerable women that will directly benefit from the project have been captured. Data captured include passport photos, name, and age, number of dependents, ages of dependents, location, farm size, and level of education. one of the beneficiaries who cannot wait to benefit from this intervention project is Madam Ama Doris and dependents pictured below.







Madam Ama Doris is a single parent who has five children. She is among the vulnerable women that will benefit greatly from the project.

She lives in a dilapidated mud structure with her five children. Currently the target population, including Madam Ama Doris live on less than \$1 a day with their entire family. Their survival is mainly dependent on left-over and support from benevolent people.

This project will enable each member earn \$150 to \$350 every month. To people like Madam Doris, this is a huge income and a massive life turnaround. This income will enable the beneficiaries do the following:

- i. Achieve zero post-harvest losses
- ii. Provide two square meals for their families;
- iii. Enroll their children in school;
- iv. Afford basic health care; and
- v. Improve their farms and have a Minimal savings
